## KEY FINDINGS

- Rod Blagojevich holds a 41%-34% lead over Republican challenger Judy Baar Topinka. In a survey conducted in early April 2006, Topinka held a 44-41% lead over incumbent Rod Blagojevich. Over the past two months, Topinka has lost 10% while Blagojevich's numbers have not moved.
- Judy Baar Topinka has seen support among Republican voters drop from a post primary level of 81% to a current level of 65%. Her support among Democrats has dropped from 20% to 11%. Her support among independent voters has remained steady at 39%.
- This drop in Topinka support has not generated any increase in Blagojevich support. Rather, Blagojevich continues to hold at 41% of the vote as he was in April 2006. In November 2006 he was at 39% of the vote. At this point, Blagojevich appears to be unable to move additional voters into the support column.
- Voters have not shifted from Topinka to Blagojevich. Rather, they have shifted from Topinka to the "Undecided" category.
- 43% of the voters think the administration of Governor Rod Blagojevich has as much corruption or more than his predecessor, Governor George Ryan. 41% of voters think the Blagojevich administration has less corruption than that of his predecessor.
- Of those that think the Blagojevich administration has less corruption, Blagojevich leads Topinka by a 60%-23% margin (17% undecided).
- Of those that think the Blagojevich administration has the same amount or more corruption, Topinka leads Blagojevich by a 53%-25% margin (22% undecided).
- In the race for State Treasurer, Alexi Giannoulis and Christine Radogno have moved into a statistical dead heat with Giannoulis leading Radogno 30-26% -- within the 4% margin of error. An extremely large 42% of the electorate is undecided.
- Giannoulis appears to have lost his post primary bounce which saw him leading Radogno in early April by a margin of 38%-27%.
