Penn Schoen Berland conducted 4,809 phone interviews among likely voters in November congressional election in the following congressional districts: Michigan 7, Arizona 1, Illinois 11, Maryland 1, New Mexico 2, Nevada 3, Ohio 16, Virginia 2, Colorado 4, Ohio 15, Virginia 5, and Pennsylvania 3. Fielding began Saturday, Sept. 25, 2010 and ended on Thursday, Sept. 30, 2010. The aggregate sample has a margin of error of 1.4\%, larger for subgroups.

## ILLINOIS $11^{\text {th }}$ DISTRICT

Penn Schoen Berland conducted 401 phone interviews among likely voters in November congressional election in Illinois $11^{\text {th }}$ congressional district. Fielding began Tuesday, Sept. 28, 2010 and ended on Thursday 30, 2010. The following audiences are broken out in this report:

- Base: Individuals who plan to vote in the mid-term election. ( $\mathrm{N}=401, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 4.9$ )
- D: Individuals who consider themselves a Democrat ( $\mathrm{N}=92, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 10.2$ )
- R: Individuals who consider themselves a Republican ( $\mathrm{N}=144, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 8.2$ )
- I: Individuals who consider themselves an Independent ( $\mathrm{N}=136$, MOE $\pm 8.4$ )
- $\quad$ Males ( $\mathrm{N}=217, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 6.6$ )
- $\quad$ Females $(\mathrm{N}=184, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 7.2)$
- 18-34: Respondents aged 18 to 34 years old ( $\mathrm{N}=28, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 18.5$ )
- 35-54: Respondents aged 35-54 years old ( $\mathrm{N}=151, \mathrm{MOE} \pm 8.0$ )
- 55+: Respondents aged 55 years old or greater ( $\mathrm{N}=200$, MOE $\pm 6.9$ )
