Key Findings from a Survey of 600 Registered Voters April 20-22, 2015





Public Opinion Strategies conducted a survey of 600 registered voters in Illinois. Four-hundred and twenty respondents were contacted via landline and 180 via cell phone.

The survey was conducted April 20-22, 2015 and has a margin of error of <u>+</u> 4.0%.






The State's Political Environment

Voters across party lines are VERY negative about the direction of the state.


Generally speaking, would you say that things in Illinois are going in the right direction, or have they pretty seriously gotten off the wrong track?






Mirroring downbeat attitudes toward the direction of the state, the legislature's approval rating is strongly inverted.

And, do you approve or disapprove of the job the state legislature is doing?




Just a few months in office, the Governor's approval rating is slightly more positive than negative.

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He's getting the benefit of the doubt from voters in the collar counties and downstate.



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
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Perceptions of Illinois Public Schools

A strong majority of Illinois voters believe public schools in the state are off on the wrong track.


Do you think public schools in the state are generally headed in the right direction or are they pretty seriously off on the wrong track?



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
Parents, including both moms and dads, are just as negative about the direction of the state's public schools.

And, few Illinois voters believe the quality of education in the state's public schools has gotten better over the last couple of years.


Do you believe the quality of education in the state's public schools has gotten better, gotten worse, or stayed about the same over the last few years?



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
Moms and dads agree.

In fact, most Illinois voters give the state's public schools a "C."


And, if you could give a grade to public schools in Illinois, that is schools from Kindergarten to 12th grade, what grade would you give them – A, B, C, D or F?*

And, which ONE of the following would you say should be the top priority to improve Illinois' public schools today? Parents Non-




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
There's clearly a sentiment that the state's public schools are not adequately funded.

And, do you believe that public schools in the state are adequately funded or not?



And, do you believe the state of Illinois is getting its money's worth out of education dollars that are spent in the state's public schools?




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School Choice

Generally speaking, do you support or oppose providing parents with more choices in where they can send their kids to school?




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Support for more choice extends across party lines.




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Charter Public Schools

A majority of Illinois voters have seen, read or heard "a lot" or "some" about charter public schools in the state.


And, on another topic, how much have you seen, read or heard about charter public schools here in Illinois?


By nearly a two-to-one margin, Illinois voters view charter public schools favorably.

And, generally speaking, do you have a favorable or unfavorable impression of charter public schools?




Charter public schools have a positive image across party lines and throughout the state.

And, charter public schools are viewed favorably across ethnicity.




Each charter public school gives the same state tests, meets the same core academic requirements, and abides by the same strict standards for civil rights, safety and health as other schools. But, they are not usually bound by union contracts.

Now that you have heard some more information, do you have a favorable or unfavorable impression of charter public schools?




Even more voters have a positive impression.

Republicans and Independents become bigger fans, while Democrats remain mixed.


Do you have a favorable or unfavorable impression of charter public schools?



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The image of charter public schools improves across the state.


Do you have a favorable or unfavorable impression of charter public schools?




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

Illinois voters strongly support giving parents of students in low-performing schools an option of attending a charter school.



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
Illinois voters also strongly support making it easier for charter public schools to expand in their area of the state.
