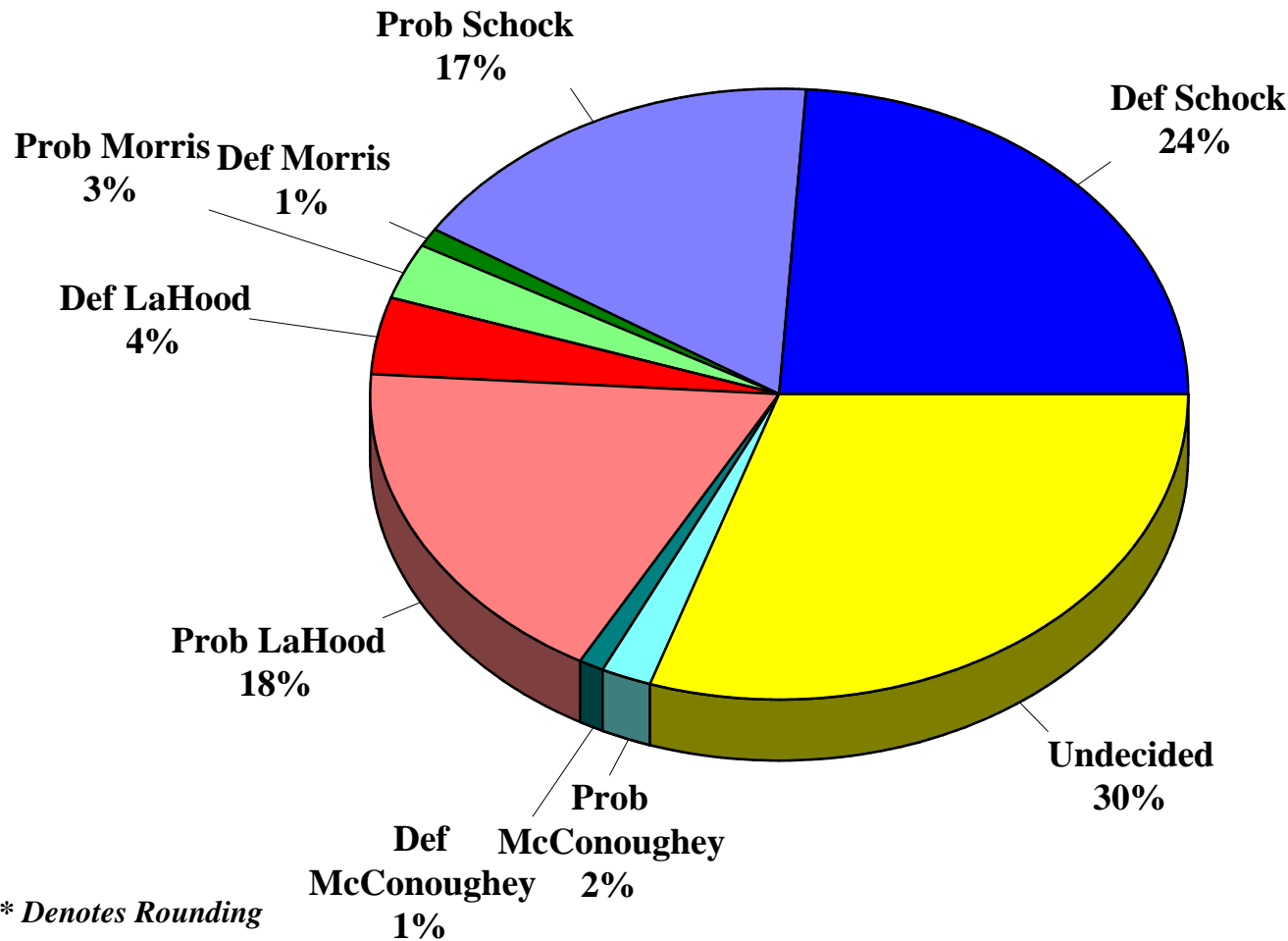


In a four-way race, Aaron Schock is out front with 41%, leading his nearest competitor by almost two to one. His intensity is good this far from the election.

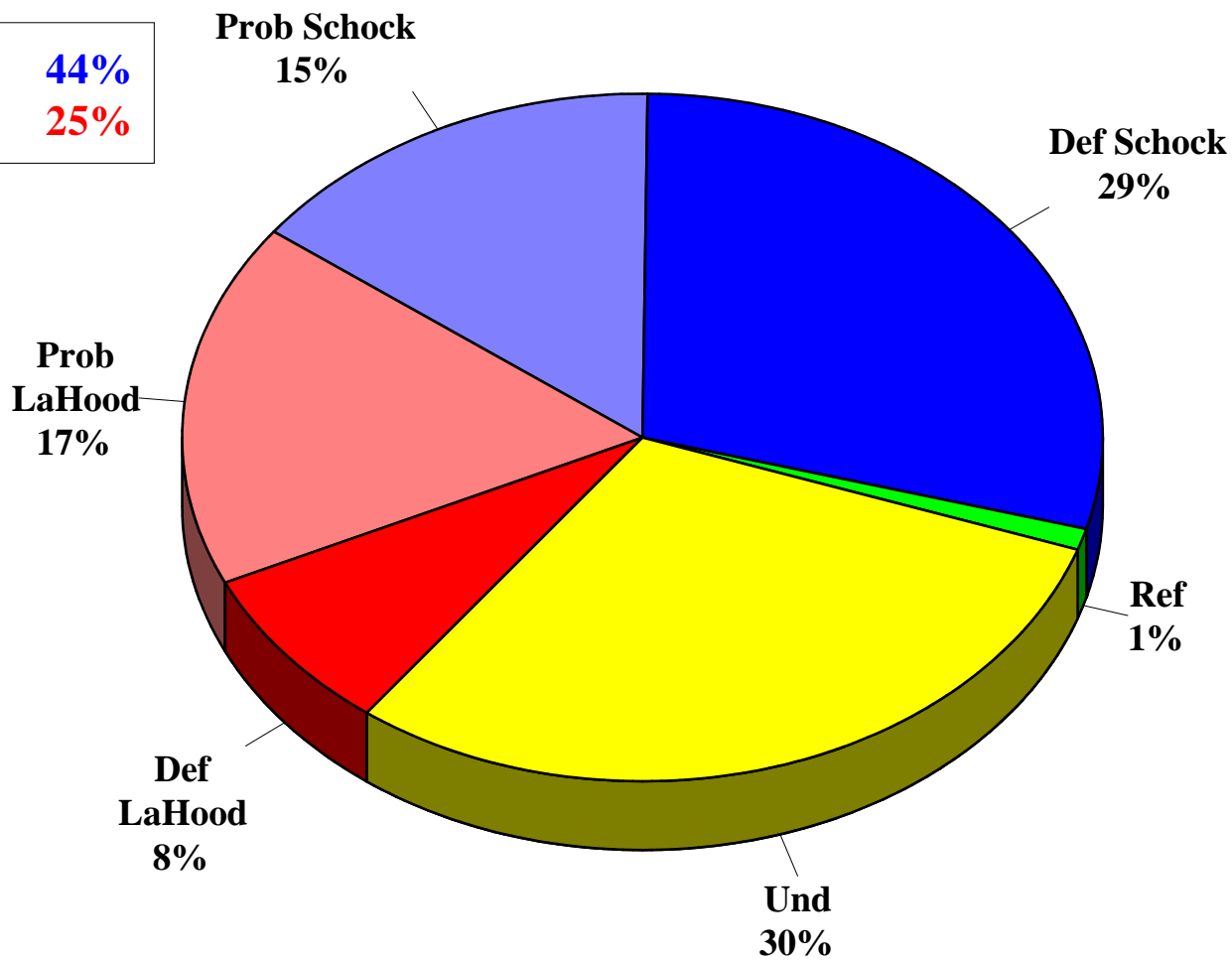
Total Shock:	41%

In a two-way race with Darin LaHood, Aaron is out to an early lead, both overall and in intensity.

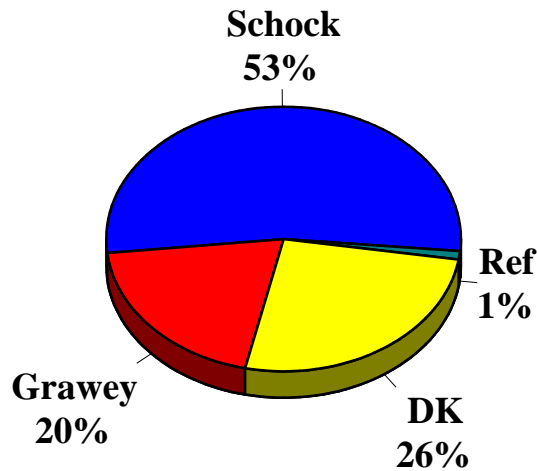

Total LaHood:	25%

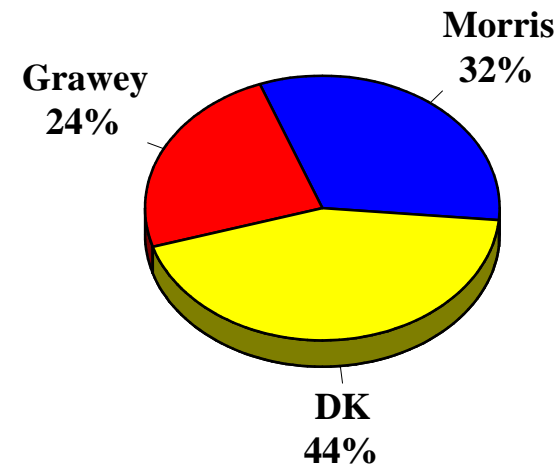


These ballot match-ups against Richard Grawey demonstrate that Aaron Schock is the best candidate to face the Democratic nominee next November.

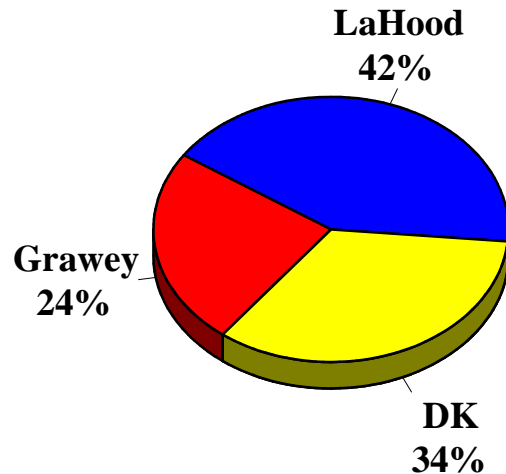
Schock/Grawey Ballot
